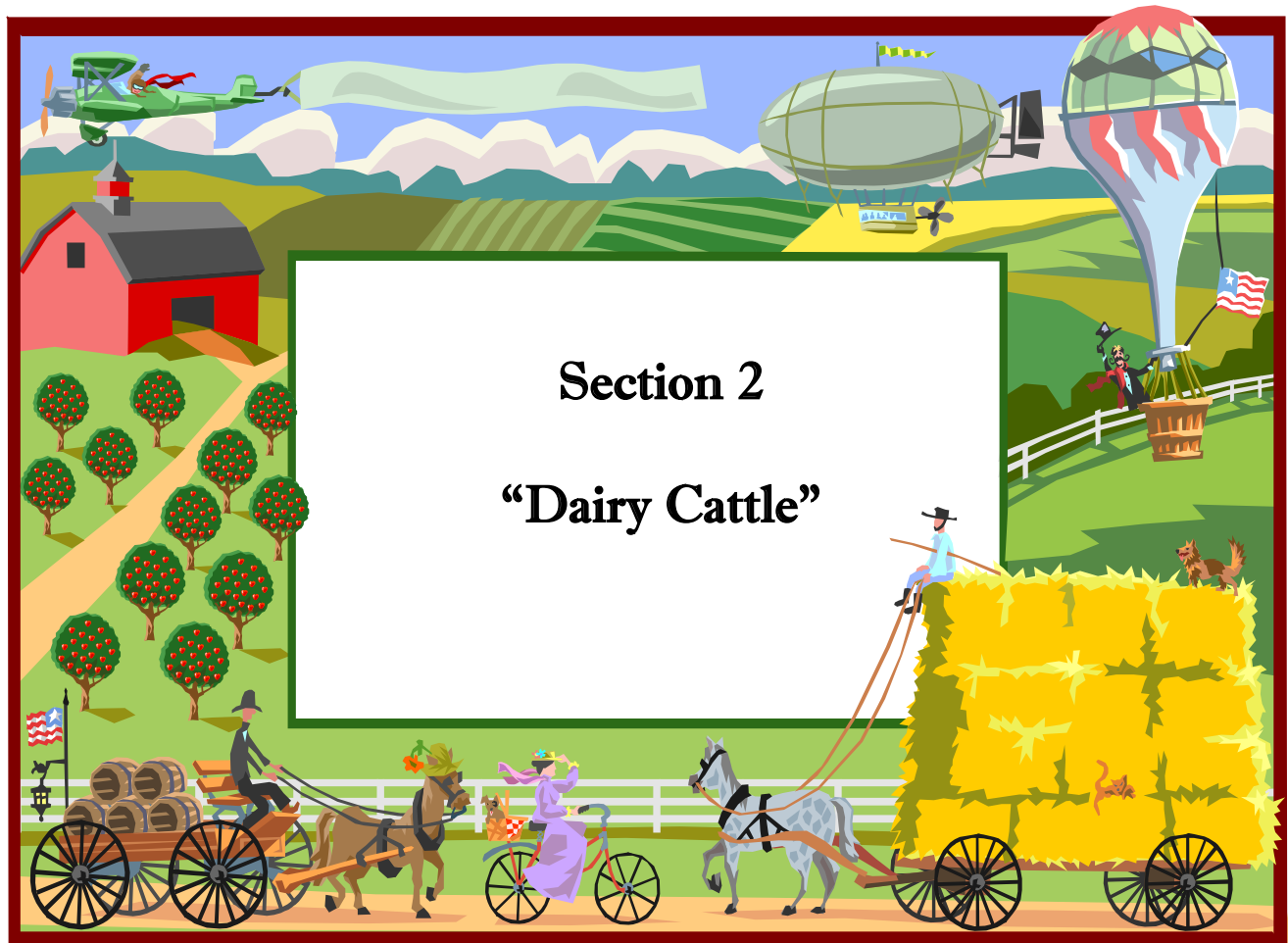

WORK PLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

Any exhibitors intending to bring equipment to the showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Work Place Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Kalbar Showground's. Exhibitors should check electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showground's to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

PIC # QHBN1637: All cattle traveling to the Kalbar Showground's MUST have an NLIS device applied before leaving property of origin (this includes calves).

All cattle present at a Show must have the individual identifications read and the movements to and from the site recorded on the showground's Property Identifications Code (PIC) in the database.

On Arrival

1. On arrival at the Kalbar Showground's the exhibitor is to present all animals' NLIS number(s) (this is the visual number on the NLIS device or the electronic number read by a device reader) to have the NLIS device read at the designated time and place.
2. Supply the PIC of the property the animals are last registered to.
3. Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/Waybill number

On Departure

1. Supply any animal's NLIS number(s) that are different from arrival
2. The PIC where the animals will return to.
3. Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/waybill number.
4. NLIS

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. TUBERCULOSIS (ALL CATTLE)
 - (a) From herds classified as Tested Negative (TN), Monitored Negative (MN) or Confirmed Free (CF) – **No Test Required**
 - (b) From herds classified as Provisionally Clear (PC), Non-Assessed (NA), Infected (IN), Suspect (SU) or Restricted (RD) – **No Entry**
2. BRUCELLOSIS (ALL BREEDING CATTLE)
 - (a) From herds classified as Tested Negative (TN), Monitored Negative (MN) or Confirmed Free (CF) – **No Test Required**
 - (b) From herds classified as Provisionally Clear (PC), Non-Assessed (NA), Infected (IN), Suspect (SU) or Restricted (RD) – **No Entry**
3. ENZOOTIC BOVINE LEUCOSIS (DAIRY CATTLE ONLY)
 - (a) From herds classified as Accredited Free (AF) – **No Test Required**
 - (b) Dairy Cattle over 6 months of age other than those from EBL Accredited Free – **Herd done negative test within 6 months prior to entry to country shows.**
4. No Stud Cattle will be allowed entry to the Kalbar Showgrounds unless accompanied by weigh bridge document.
5. All competitors **MUST** pay gate admission fees.
6. Age of cattle taken from April 1st.
7. All cattle must be free of ticks.
8. All Cattle in dairy section must be entered or eligible for entry in approved Herd Book.
9. All cattle must be handled to be led and paraded before the judge.
10. Entries must be accompanied by entry fees and will close Friday, June 18th, 2010.
11. Judging to commence Saturday, June 19th 2010 at 9:00am.
12. **All** prize winners must take part in the Grand Parade at 2:00pm.
13. All cattle entered in group classes must be entered in general classes.
14. Exhibits must be in the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of the show.
15. Stewards reserve the right to inspect their tattoo.
16. Any cow or heifer entered as dry, if fresh at the time of competition shall compete as a wet cow or heifer or vice versa, and it shall be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to notify the stewards as early as possible.
17. All bulls over 12 months must have rings in nose and be led by staff or double leading rope.
18. Loading of cattle for removal from the Showground's cannot commence until all judging has been completed.

Handlers leading cattle MUST be over the age of TWELVE (12)
