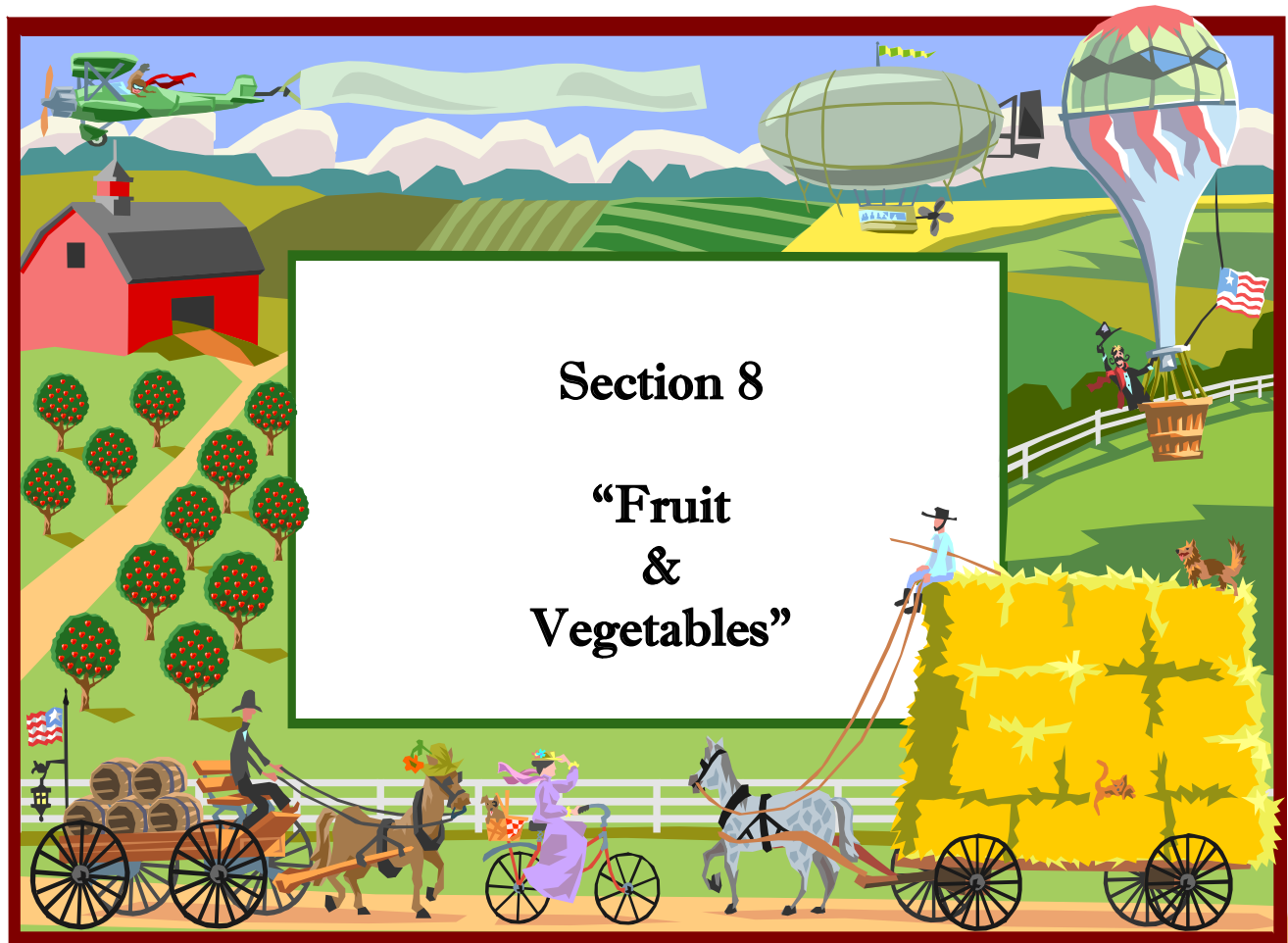

3. Fruit & Vegetables to have stems left on.
4. **Exhibitor Points Calculation:**
 - Any First Place - 3 points,
 - Any Second Place - 2 points
 - Any Third Place - 1 point.
5. All exhibits in this section must be delivered no later than 9:00am on Friday, June 18th 2010.
6. **Junior Section:**
 - **Exhibitors MUST be aged between 2 and 15 years of age.**
 - **One Entry allowed in each class per exhibitor**
7. Prize Money may be picked up after 3:00pm on Saturday, June 19th 2010.
8. The Society will not accept any liability for produce exhibited, the risk being that of the exhibitor.
9. Electrical Equipment- Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment and or gas bottles to the showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor or gas fitter.
