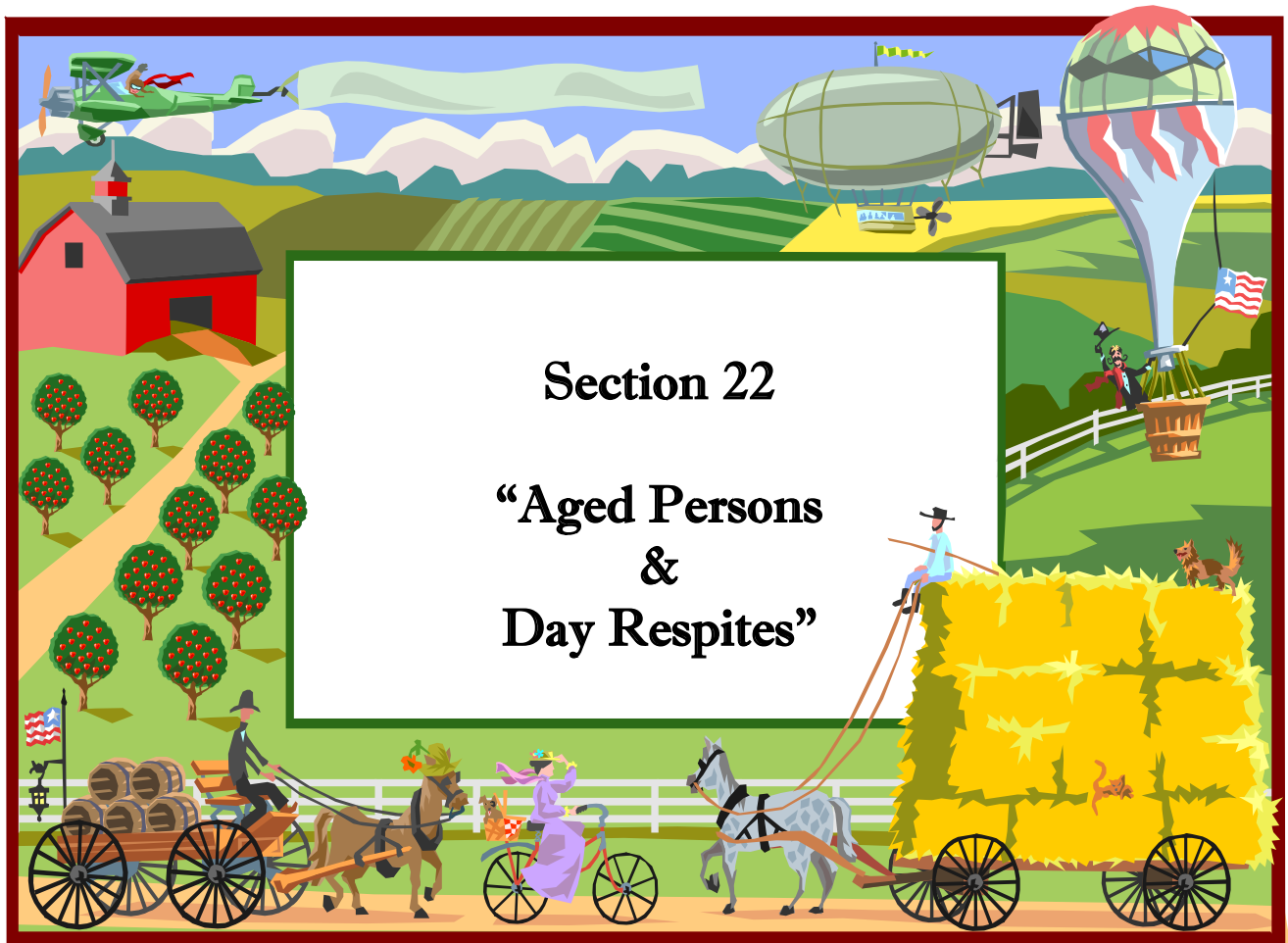

WORK PLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

Any exhibitors intending to bring equipment to the showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Work Place Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Kalbar Showground's. Exhibitors should check electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showground's to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **All Exhibitors must be a resident of a aged person home or attend a day respite facility**
2. All exhibits to be in the hands of the Secretary by 12 noon, Wednesday, June 16th 2010.
3. All exhibits must have securely labeled, the exhibits name and facility clearly attached or on the back of the entry
4. Each participating facility may submit a “facility Banner” for display with the entries, allowing participating facilities to be recognized.
5. Every effort will be made to display all entries at Kalbar Show.
6. Judging to commence at 10:00am on Friday, June 18th, 2010.
7. **Exhibitor Points Calculation:**
 - Any First Place - 3 points,
 - Any Second Place - 2 points
 - Any Third Place - 1 point.
 - Any Champion – 3 points.
 - Any Reserve Champion – 2 points
8. Prize Money may be picked up after 3:00pm on Saturday, June 19th 2010.
9. The Society will provide greatest care but will not accept any liability for items exhibited, the risk being that of the exhibitor.
10. Electrical Equipment- Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment and or gas bottles to the showground’s will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor or gas fitter. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and general public and is a requirement of work place health and safety act of 1995. The act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed on the Kalbar showground’s. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and all gas bottles to avoid occurrences of any difficulties
