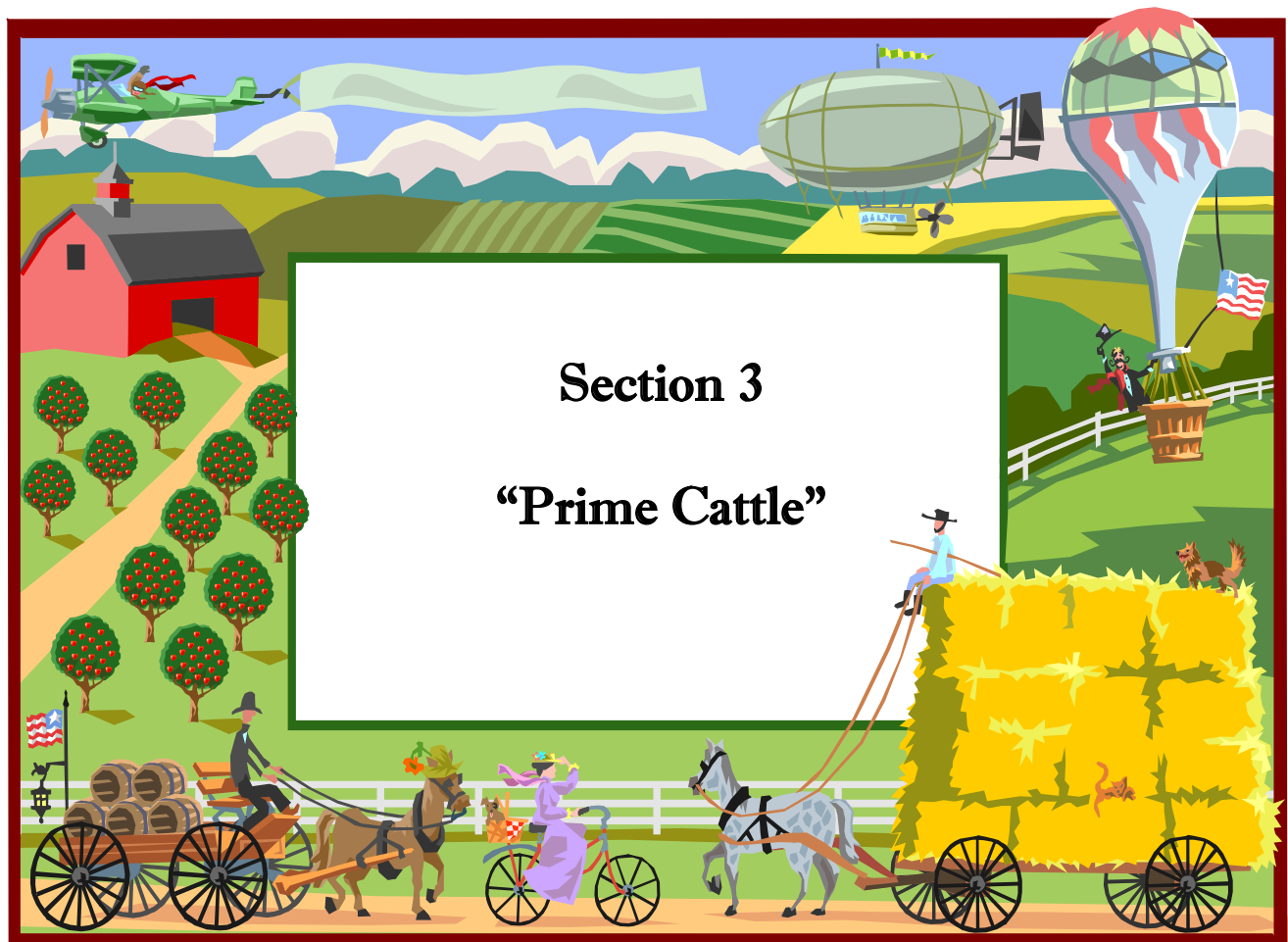

WORK PLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

Any exhibitors intending to bring equipment to the showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Work Place Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Kalbar Showground's. Exhibitors should check electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showground's to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

NATIONAL LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

PIC # QHBN1637: All cattle traveling to the Kalbar Showground's MUST have an NLIS device applied before leaving property of origin (this includes calves).

All cattle present at a Show must have the individual identifications read and the movements to and from the site recorded on the showground's Property Identifications Code (PIC) in the database.

On Arrival

- On arrival at the Kalbar Showground's the exhibitor is to present all animals' NLIS number(s) (this is the visual number on the NLIS device or the electronic number read by a device reader) to have the NLIS device read at the designated time and place.
- Supply the PIC of the property the animals are last registered to.
- Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/Waybill number

On Departure

- Supply any animal's NLIS number(s) that are different from arrival
- The PIC where the animals will return to.
- Supply Move Easy Waybill or NVD/waybill number.

1. All cattle in this section shall be bona fide property of the exhibitor for 2 months.
2. An exhibitor in this section cannot compete in more than one class.
3. **ALL FAT CATTLE TO BE HORN TIPPED EXCEPT VEALER CLASSES.**
4. No competitor permitted to enter judging area while judging is in progress (unless they are a steward)
5. Any exhibit found to be incorrectly entered may be transferred at the discretion of the stewards.
6. Cattle not accompanied by a fully completed Waybill & NVD will be refused entry.
7. All cattle to be offered for sale, if passed in, commission to be paid on last bid.
8. Entries close 6.00p.m. Thursday 17th June, 2010.
9. All cattle to be penned by 6.00 p.m. Friday 18th June, 2010.
10. Judging to commence 8.00 a.m. Saturday 19th June, 2010
11. **Sale Auction:** GST is added at fall of hammer where applicable to cattle
