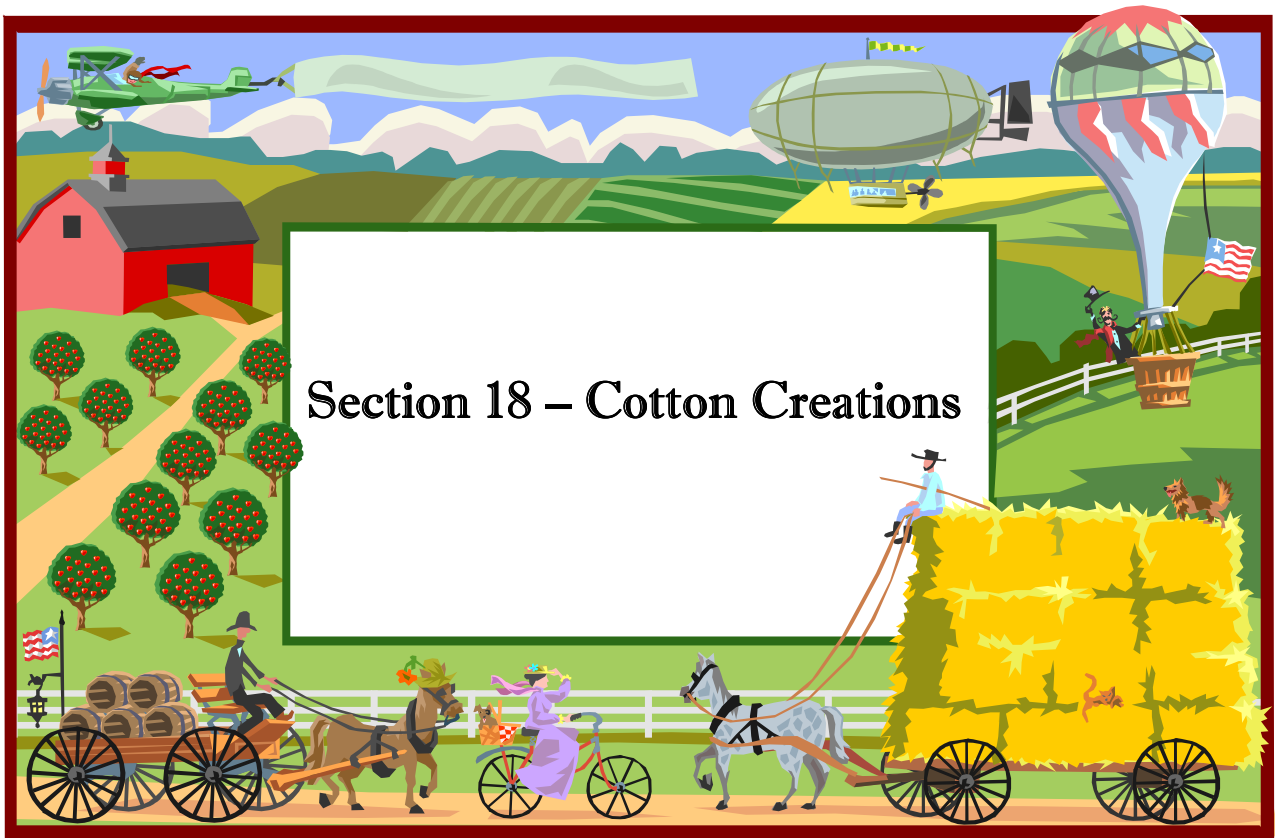

WORK PLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

Any exhibitors intending to bring equipment to the showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public as is a requirement of the Work Place Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Kalbar Showgrounds. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showgrounds to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

Class 1:

“RESTRICTED OUTFIT” – Suitable for Any Occasion including After 5

- Open to ages 15 to 20 years inclusive. **Age of entrant is to be stated on Form “B”.**
- Fabric used in outfit to cost no more than \$100.00. Receipts to be supplied for proof of cost.
(Please note: age 15 has been chosen as the RNA consider this to be the age that adult entrance fee must be paid).

Class 2:

OPEN – “ADULT OUTFIT” – Daywear

- Suitable for Race Meeting, Business Meeting, Special Occasion, Garden Party or Wedding.

Class 3:

OPEN – “CREATIVE OUTFIT: - Suitable for Any Occasion including After 5

- **This is not a Fashion Fantasy class**, but entries are required to feature creativity and innovation using craft, machine or hand embroidery, patchwork, quilting, smocking e.g. and should have the initial visual impact of a creative entry.

Class 4:

“MASTERS” ADULT OUTFIT – DAYWEAR – Any Occasion

- Open to all entrants providing they comply with the Master’s Class entry rule listed below.

Class 5:

“FASHION FANTASY” – WEARABLE ART

(Please note: outfit cannot be created from purchased garments). All parts of entry are to be made by the entrant.

- Open to individuals as well as all students of a high school, college or tertiary facility.
- The actual garment **MUST** be predominately made from cotton or cotton blend fabric of not less than 50% cotton. Entrant may add other materials and items to complete the design.
- Entrant is to model their own outfit.

Let your imagination run wild!!!! This is the only class that does not need to be pre-judged at local show level.

ALL COTTON CREATIONS ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE:

- You are required to read the Terms & Conditions of Entry listed in this booklet.
- **This is a competition that promotes the Cotton Industry in Queensland. All parts of your entry (except linings) MUST be made from cotton or cotton blend fabrics of not less than 50% cotton.**
- An 8cm square sample of each fabric used is to be attached to Entry Form A. Entries that do not comply with the required cotton content will not be eligible to compete at final level. You may not use purchased garments to complete your entry. Each part of your entry is to be made by the entrant. (Accessories excluded)
- **No models will be provided for Fashion Fantasy entries.**
- Age of entrant for **Restricted** and **Fashion Fantasy** classes is to be included on the entry form.
- **CLASS 4 MASTER CLASS** – is open to anyone who does not derive a major part of their income from dressmaking and/or have a registered dressmaking business, conduct classes, own their own fashion label or who has won a 1st place at a previous State Final in Classes 2 or 3.
- **ALL OTHER CLASSES** – open to all persons who *do not derive any income* from dressmaking and/or conduct sewing classes and have not previously won a first prize at state level in the class entered.
- No child's outfit will be accepted in the Cotton Creations classes.

SECTION 18 - KIDS IN COTTON CLASSES

Class 1:

“PARTY WEAR” - For those special occasions – birthday party, wedding or their 1st dance.

- Slacks and Shirt, Skirt and Blouse or Dress (No shorts).
- Ages 5 to 12 inclusive.

Class 2:

“CASUAL/ACTIVE WEAR” – For Fun, Sun, Play or Sport

- Shorts/Track Pants/Skirt and Shirt/Blouse.
- Ages 5 to 12 inclusive

Class 3:

“SHOWTIME’ – For a Country Show, Movies or BBQ

- Pants and Shirt, Dress or Skirt and Blouse. (No shorts).
- Ages 5 to 12 inclusive

Class 4:

“SELFMADE – PRIMARY” – Any Occasion

- Ages 8 to 11 inclusive. Age is to be noted on Entry Form.
- Garment is to be cut and sewn as much as possible by the entrant, but they may receive help.

Class 5:

“SELF MADE” – Any Occasion

- Ages 12 to 14 inclusive. Age of entrant to be noted on entry form.
- Garment is to be cut and sewn by the entrant without assistance. They may receive advice only.

ALL KIDS IN COTTON ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE:

All entrants are required to read the Terms & Conditions of Entry detailed in this booklet.

This is a competition that promotes the Cotton Industry in Queensland. All parts of your entry (except linings) MUST be made from cotton or cotton blend fabrics of not less than 50% cotton.

An 8cm square sample of each fabric used is to be attached to Entry Form A. Entries that do not comply will not be eligible to compete at final level. You may not use purchased garments to complete your entry. Each part of your entry is to be made by the entrant.

A condition of entry in Classes 4 and 5 – “Self Made” is that the entrant is to model their own outfit.

Entrants in Classes 1 to 3 are asked to make every attempt to find their own models. PLEASE NOTE – **MINIMUM AGE FOR A MODEL IS 5 YEARS.** If you are unable to provide your own model, please attach a note to your entry requesting that we try to find a model. No guarantee is given that a model can be found.

The age of all models and sizes of all garments is to be noted on the entry form. **The “Occasion” that the entry was made for is to also be noted on the entry form.**

Outfits can be for boys or girls.

Shorts are permitted in the Casual/Active Wear Section only.

ALL CLASSES – open to all persons who *do not derive any income* from dressmaking and/or conduct sewing classes and have not previously won a first prize at state level in the class entered.
